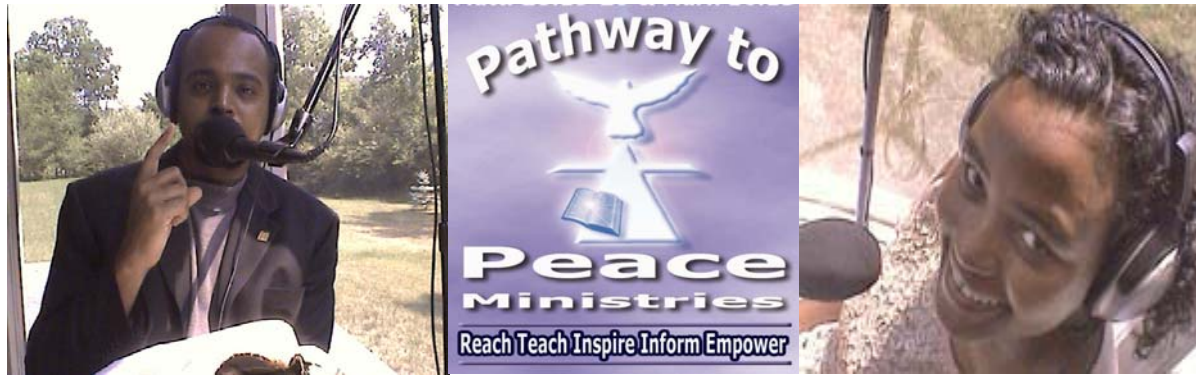


Cary & Elene Rodgers Biographical Sketch



Cary and Elene Rodgers, founders of *Pathway to Peace Ministries*, have been happily married for over twelve years and are the proud parents of two children, Carlene and Elijah. Cary and Elene Rodgers are a young dynamic duo on fire for the Lord. Their only mission in life is to teach, reach, inspire, and empower others through the power of God's Holy Word about a loving Saviour, Jesus Christ, who died for the sins world. They both are Bible believing Christians who have the urgency and fervency to teach the truths of the Bible in a practical way in which others can make God's Word a reality in their lives.

Cary and Elene both met and graduated from Oakwood College, a Christian college in Huntsville, AL, with Bachelor of Social Work degrees. In 1995, Cary also received his Master of Social Work at Walla Walla College in College Place, WA.

Cary and Elene have been an active team and members of their church for many years. They both have served as Bible school teachers, youth leaders, and family life directors in the church for several years. Cary has also served as a church Elder for over four years.

Before God called them both to start a full-time ministry, Cary worked as a social worker in the community and the school system for seven years in Charlotte, NC. In 2000, Cary earned a computer certification as a Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer and worked as a computer trainer and manager for about two years. Beginning in 1996, Elene was owner and director of Basics and Beyond tutoring center in Charlotte, NC. Later she worked as a real estate broker until 2002.

In spring of 2002, God inspired Cary and Elene to start a weekly radio broadcast, Pathway to Peace, with testimonies, inspiring words, and Bible study. On April 27, 2002 they started with live broadcasts on WGSP 1310 AM in Charlotte, NC. They only intended to do 10 live radio broadcasts but God had other plans for their lives. After the 10 radio broadcasts were completed, God inspired them to continue to produce and present more radio programs, so they signed a year contract with the radio station and continued on until the station was bought by another company.

Since then God has commissioned them both to full-time ministry, Pathway to Peace Ministries, which is now based in Willis, MI. Pathway to Peace Ministries continues to produce and expand the Radio Bible Class broadcasts which air on 18 full powered stations in North Carolina, South Carolina, Alabama, Indiana, Pennsylvania, New Mexico, Kansas, Tennessee, Georgia, and Mississippi. The radio broadcasts is also part of the Radio 74 International network which broadcast to several LP stations in the US and its apart of the 3ABN / Hope Channel satellite network. Currently, Pathway to Peace Ministries is in the process of expanding into a television version of its radio broadcast. Over the past three years they also have been intimately involved in prison, youth, street, and health ministries.
