Enter Into Sanctification Experience in Holy Place.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

We MUST GO Through the Justification and Sanctification process in the Sanctuary to have TOTAL VICTORY OVER SIN!

1 Corinthians 6:11

11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are **sanctified(made holy)**, but ye are **justified (made blameless)** in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

The Tabernacle Experience = Sanctification Experience that's in the Holy (Sacred) Place

- Walking in the Holy Place experience "BE YE HOLY" :
- Sanctification=Gk: Purification the process of being made holy!
- The Holy Place is for a Holy People to live a holy life >Victory over sin!

Leviticus 19:2 Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: for I the LORD your God *am* holy.

<u>1 Peter 1:15-16</u>

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

The entrance "the Door"

Five golden pillars that holds up a covering of fine twined linen of blue, purple, and scarlet

Exodus 26:36-37

36 And thou shalt make an hanging for the door of the tent, *of* blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework.

37 And thou shalt make for the hanging <u>five pillars</u> of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold, and their hooks *shall be of* gold: and thou shalt cast five sockets of brass for them.

Shittim wood (Hebrew) = acacia tree, acacia wood (see picture) – 1,000's of species

What does the five pillars wood overlaid with Gold represent?

- Pillars occupy the central position to uphold or to support the weight of a building
- 5 Pillars at entrance hold up the "door" or cover that goes into the Tabernacle & Holy Place

- 4 Pillars at the entrance of the gate into the court yard hold up the covering....
- 4 pillars at the entrance = 4 gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John) that give us a complete picture of Christ and reality of Plan of Salvation in action. We see the fulfillment of the sanctuary in action!
- 5 Pillars (Support, hold up, etc..) Pre-Gospel book

 Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government (Hebrew: EMPIRE) shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

<u>Jesus is the support pillars that describe five names that define his character and work.</u> Each pillar are the five names of Jesus that uphold the empire (the Kingdom of God) & the Plan of Salvation.

1. Wonderful **2.** Counselor **3.** The Mighty God **4.** The Everlasting Father **5.** The Prince of Peace

The Golden Room – The Holy Place

- Exodus 26:15 30:
- 48 Board panels (15 feet by 27 inches) made of shittim wood overlaid with gold = walls of the tabernacle
- 20 panels upright on the North and 20 panels on the South sides
- 6 panels on the West side with 2 corner panels (20+20+6+2=48)

Walls represent?

Protection, Jesus is our protection from the enemy when we are inside the walls of the tabernacle (The boundaries of Jesus)

What does the gold in the sanctuary represent? (\$87 million)

Job 22:25 Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence (Hebrew=Gold), and thou shalt have plenty of silver.

Gold = The Almighty God! (Jesus)

Isaiah 13:12 I (The Almighty God) will make a man more precious than fine gold; even a man than the golden wedge of Ophir.

Gold = Our characters that reflect the holy and perfect character of the Almighty God (Jesus!)
