(15) Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. (16) They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. (17) For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes." Revelation 7:9,10,13-17

The Power

Before entering battle at Jericho the soldiers had each been given a command concerning the things in the city. The city and everything within the city was accursed. They where forbidden from taking anything from the accursed city. The command was given, "...keep yourselves from the accursed thing, lest ye make yourselves accursed, when ye take of the accursed thing, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it." Joshua 6:17,18

Each day for six days they marched around the city once. On the seventh day they marched seven times around the city. After the seventh march the priests sounded with a long blast from rams' horns and the men of war shouted with a great shout and the mighty wall of Jericho fell. A great victory had been won that day.

God used this to show that it was the "Lord of host" that fought their battles. The success of the mission did not depend on the ability nor power of Joshua neither the size of his army but obedience.

The whole congregation of Israel rejoiced at this great victory. They

were ready to take on the next city Ai. This city was smaller than Jericho. When Joshua sent spies to Ai they came back with the report, "Let not all the people go up; but let about two or three thousand men go up and smite Ai; and make not all the people to labour thither; for they are but few." Joshua 7:3

According to suggestion of the spies, they only sent out 3,000 soldiers to take Ai "and they fled before the men of Ai." "...The men of Ai smote of them about thirty and six men...". This was an unbearable defeat for the children of Israel. "...The hearts of the people melted, and became as water." "...Joshua rent his clothes" and in utter despair fell to the earth upon his face before the ark of the LORD until the eventide, he and the elders of Israel, and put dust upon their heads." Joshua 7:4,5

"And the LORD said unto Joshua, Get thee up; wherefore liest thou thus upon thy face? Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and

they have put it even among their own stuff. Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, but turned their backs before their enemies, because they were accursed..." Joshua 7:10-12

Sin was in the camp. Sadly, a soldier took of the accursed thing. The Lord straightly told Joshua, "...neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you." "...There is an accursed thing in the midst of thee, O Israel: thou canst not stand before thine enemies, until ye take away the accursed thing from among you." Joshua 7:12,13 They had lost the power that gave them the victory at Jericho. Unless the accursed things was removed from the mist of the camp they would not be able to stand.

Joshua arose from the ground to meet the crisis. The guilty one was searched out and found. His name was Achan. After he had been caught he confessed, "When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they are hid in the earth in the

midst of my tent, and the silver under it." Joshua 7:21

Just as the Lord commanded, the children of Israel took Achan and all that he had and stoned him and laid a heap of stones upon him.

With the accursed thing removed "... the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear not, neither be thou dismayed: take all the people of war with thee, and arise, go up to Ai: see, I have given into thy hand the king of Ai, and his people, and his city, and his land". Joshua 8:1 A great victory was gained, and the city of Ai fell. (Read Joshua chapter 8).

This story has many lessons for the church today. As we enter the final battle of great controversy between Christ and the Devil, his attacks on God's church will only become more fierce. The Bible says, "And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ." Revelation 12:17

In these times we must realize that our success as a church does not depend on our ability and degrees, nor the number of schools, universities, and hospitals. Just as with Israel when entering the promised land, our success depends on faithful obedience to "every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." Matthew 4:4



Bible Warning against Modern Pantheism



God gave a warning in the Bible for His people to take heed in order not to be deceived into false worship. Deuteronomy 12:29-32 plainly states, "When the LORD thy God shall cut off the nations from before thee, whither thou goest to possess them, and thou succeedest them, and dwellest in their land; (30) Take heed to thyself that thou


be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before thee; and that thou enquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? even so will I do likewise. (31) Thou shalt not do so unto the LORD thy God: for every abomination to the LORD, which he hateth, have they done unto their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. (32) What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it."

The story of King Ahaz is given as an example of someone who did not take heed to this warning from God: "But he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, yea, and made his son to pass through the fire, according to the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD cast out from before the children of Israel. And he sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places, and on the hills, and under every green tree." (2 Kings 16:3,4)

The details of the false worship that he instituted are given in 2 Kings 16:10-

16: "And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that was at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof. (11) And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made it against king Ahaz came from Damascus. (12) And when the king was come from Damascus, the king saw the altar: and the king approached to the altar, and offered thereon (13) And he burnt his burnt offering and his meat offering, and poured his drink offering, and sprinkled the blood of his peace offerings, upon the altar. (14) And he brought also the brasen altar, which was before the LORD, from the forefront of the house, from between the altar and the house of the LORD, and put it on the north side of the altar. (15) And king Ahaz commanded Urijah the priest, saying, Upon the great altar burn the morning burnt offering, and the evening meat offering, and the king's burnt sacrifice, and his meat offering, with the burnt offering of all the people of the land, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings; and sprinkle upon it all the blood of the burnt offering, and all the blood of the sacrifice: and the brasen altar shall be for me to enquire by. (16) Thus did Urijah the priest, according to all that king Ahaz commanded."

King Ahaz's worship moved the Altar of Burnt Offering from its original position and purpose: No longer was it the first article that you saw when you entered into the temple! No longer was it used as the place for the burnt offering or sacrifice for sin but it was only to "enquire by"! The Altar that was at Damascus was added to the temple service and on it were the offerings made.

Eventually, this led to further apostasy and closure of the temple altogether: "And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut

up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem. (25) And in every several city of Judah he made high places to burn incense unto other gods, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers." (2 Chronicles 28:24,25)

This false worship permitted a false god while still including the worship of the true God which is a form of pantheism. Pantheism has 2 main definitions: 1) A doctrine that identifies God with the universe or regards the universe as a manifestation of God. 2) A worship that admits or tolerates all gods.

The first definition has been referred as the alpha of apostasy by Ellen White. The second definition of pantheism is the omega of apostasy. "In the book Living Temple there is presented the alpha of deadly heresies. The omega will follow, and will be received by those who are not willing to heed the warning God has given." {1SM 200.1}

This warning given by God applies to us today. There is a movement by Christians to incorporate false worship along with the worship of God known as interfaith dialogue. "Interfaith dialogue is an organized effort to engage in a discussion of beliefs, along with a sharing of religious and/or cultural-community oriented practices, which takes place between people of differing faiths. The goal of such a dialogue is to break down barriers between adherents of differing faiths, and once accomposolished purportedly leads to world peace." "... participants in interfaith dialogue must come to the discussion table with an open mind toward the acceptance of so-called

multiple truths, as well as an openness with regard to the welcoming of multiple means of worshipping a deity or deities." "Interfaith dialogue denies one crucially important reality, that being, there are incompatible fundamental distinctions between the deeply held beliefs of differing religions throughout the world. Because of this fact, it is impossible for religions to be combined or somehow blended together, without suffering the loss of the vital integrity of the respective faiths." (Down the Path To One World Religion Newsmax by James Hirsen)

The atonement offered only through the blood of Jesus Christ as the offering for sin is the vital belief that is moved out of place in interfaith dialogue. Many false religions may mention the name of Jesus but not worship Him as the Creator and Savior of the world. Moreover, some pagan religions despise the foundational beliefs of Christianity because it refuses to validate immoral behavior that the Scriptures overtly condemns.

Jesus' example of witnessing to those of different faiths, like the woman of Samaria, did not try to learn and incorporate heathen worship in order to minister to her. He spoke the truth in love and it touched her heart. She was fully converted in sincerity and truth.

In pagan worship there are many gods and these false gods are linked together but this is contrasted with the true worship of the Creator God whose first commandment is, "Thou shalt have no other gods before me." As Christians today, if we do not want to be seduced into idolatry, we need to take heed to the warning given from God.

Healthy Living Recipes | Alfalfa Sprouts

Sprouts

One new thing that has interested me was sprouting alfalfa and broccoli. I have thought about it before but decided to go ahead and begin. My mother already would sprout wheat berries to add nutrition for breadmaking, but I also found sprouting alfalfa seeds very exciting especially when I read on the health benefits. In less than a week it grows delicious and very nutritious sprouts. One day my brother Elijah decided to make an alfalfa salad from the alfalfa sprouts and it was very delicious! It also is a great addition to sandwich wraps like adding fresh lettuce. To me the alfalfa sprouts are mild in flavor with a light nutty taste.

How to Sprout Alfalfa Seed

- 1 quart jar
- the ring of the jar lid or rubber band or string to secure cloth over the mouth of the jar
- a small piece of cloth (I prefer a thin white cotton cloth or flour bag, very thin to allow air to enter.)
- kitchen towel or any cloth to keep the spouts in a dark environment
- strainer
- small glass pan or bowl to tilt the jar in
- 2 Tablespoons Alfalfa Seeds (make sure they are not treated with pesticides or chemicals)
- water

Step 1: In the jar pour 2 tablespoons of alfalfa seeds then fill the jar halfway with water and allow the seeds to soak overnight. Cover the lid with a small thin cloth and secure it in place with a rubber band or ring of the jar lid. Cover the jar with a kitchen towel or any cloth to keep the sprouts in a dark environment.

Step 2: After your seeds have been soaking for about 8 hours, drain out the water with a strainer then pour more water in the jar to rinse the seeds once then drain out the water. Then place the small cloth back over the mouth of the lid and secure in place then tilt the jar in a small glass pan or bowl (anything heavy enough to support the weight of the leaning jar without allowing it to tip over). Do not just place the jar right side up because you want to let the remaining water drain out. Also, do not place it upside down because you want to allow air to flow in. Just tilt the jar. Then cover the jar with a kitchen towel or any cloth to keep the sprouts in a dark environment.

Step 3: Continue to rinse and drain the sprouting seeds twice a day for 4 days covering the jar with a kitchen towel or any cloth to keep the sprouts in a dark environment.

Step 4: On the 5th day remove the kitchen towel or whatever cloth you used to keep the sprouts in a dark environment to expose the sprouts to light so the yellow tops can become green. Still rinse and drain the seeds that day. Now they are ready to eat!

Alfalfa Sprout Salad

2 cups alfalfa sprouts (my brother used both alfalfa and broccoli sprouts)

½ cup tomatoes (diced)

1 avocado (diced)

½ cup olives (sliced)

Juice from 1 lemon (freshly squeezed)

2 Tbsp. olive oil



3 Books In The Judgment

We are living in the MOST solemn times in earth's history. According to the rapid fulfillment of Bible prophecy there is no doubt that we are the last generation on this planet. Jesus summarizes His core mission of the everlasting gospel and the Holy Ghost in John 16:8-11: "And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."

The first angel's message of Revelation 14:7 says, "the hour of his judgment is come." This is an urgent message that must be given to the world. Based on the events of Bible prophecy we are living at the closing "hour" of the investigative judgment.

The prophet Daniel spoke of this time of the investigative judgment: "...the judgment was set, and the books were opened." (Daniel 7:10) The prophet John describing the same scene, adds: "Another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works." Revelation 20:12. Ellen White says in the Great Controversy page 480, "The books of record in heaven, in which the names and the deeds of men are registered, are to determine the decisions of the judgment." There are three books in the courts of heaven that are used during the investigative judgment: the Book of Life, the Book of Remembrance, and the Record Book of unconfessed Sins.

The Book of Life contains all the names of the faithful servants of God who have overcome the world and sin through the power of the blood of the Lamb, Jesus Christ. Jesus referred to the Book of Life when he spoke to the seventy workers in Luke 10:20 which says, "Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven." The book of Revelation also refers to

the book of life in Revelation 21:27 and Revelation 20:15. Revelation 21:27 says, "And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life." "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire," according to Revelation 20:15. In Philippians 4:3, Paul speaks of his faithful fellow workers, "whose names are in the Book of Life." Also in Daniel 12:1 it says, "And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book [Book of Life]."

The Book of Life is the ultimate book in which your name must be recorded in order to be saved in the Kingdom of God. Those who are in sin and rebellion names are not written in the Book of Life. They are forever lost.

The Book of Remembrance is another book used in the investigative judgment. This book records all the good deeds of the righteous and faithful people of God. This is another in which you want your name written. Malachi 3:16 says, "Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name." Nehemiah 13:14 reveal what is in the book of remembrance, "Remember me, O my God, concerning this, and wipe not out my good deeds that I have done for the house of my God, and for the offices thereof."

"In the book of God's remembrance every deed of righteousness is immortalized. There every temptation resisted, every evil overcome, every word of tender pity expressed, is faithfully chronicled. And every act of sacrifice, every suffering and sorrow endured for Christ's sake, is recorded. Says the psalmist: "Thou tellest my wanderings: put Thou my tears into Thy bottle: are they not in Thy book?" Psalm 56:8." - Ellen White, Great Controversy p. 481

The Record Book of unconfessed Sins is a book that you do not want your name written in. It is a record of all the deeds of the people with unconfessed sins. All those whose name are written in the Recorded Book of Sins will be lost and destroyed in the lake of fire. Ecclesiastes 12:14 says, "For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good [book of remembrance], or whether it be evil [Record of sins]." In addition, Matthew 12:36 makes it clear, "But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment."

"Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God." 1 Corinthians 4:5. The hidden things of the wicked are recorded and will be brought to light. Unconfessed sins will not be ignored or forgotten in the courts of Heaven. The wicked will not be able to hide anything from God because "he knoweth the secrets of the heart," Psalms 44:21. In addition Romans 2:16 says, "In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel."

God records the wicked's rebellious behavior and measures them with His standard of righteousness. He will "measure their former work" of iniquity (Isaiah 65:7).

In summary, the 3 books in the Investigative Judgment are the Book of Life, the Book of Remembrance, and the Record of Sins. "Every man's work passes in review before God and is registered for faithfulness or unfaithfulness. Opposite each name in the books of heaven is entered with terrible exactness every wrong word, every selfish act, every unfulfilled duty, and every secret sin, with every artful dissembling. Heavensent warnings or reproofs neglected, wasted moments, unimproved opportunities, the influence exerted for good or for evil, with its far-reaching results, all are chronicled by the recording angel." Great Controversy p. 482

"As the books of record are opened in the judgment, the lives of all who have believed on Jesus come in review before God. Beginning with those who first lived upon the earth, our Advocate presents the cases of each successive generation, and closes with the living. Every name is mentioned, every case closely investigated. Names are accepted, names rejected. When any have sins remaining upon the books of record, unrepented of and unforgiven, their names will be blotted out of the book of life, and the record of their good deeds will be erased from the book of God's remembrance. The Lord declared to Moses: 'Whosoever hath sinned against Me, him will I blot out of My book.' Exodus 32:33. And says the prophet Ezekiel: 'When the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, . . . all his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned.' Ezekiel 18:24." Great Controversy p. 483

What else will be closely scrutinized and examined during the investigative judgment? "In the judgment the use made of every talent will be scrutinized. How have we employed the capital lent us of Heaven? Will the Lord at His coming receive His own with usury? Have we improved the powers entrusted us, in hand and heart and brain, to the glory of God and the blessing of the world? How have we used our time, our pen, our voice, our money, our influence? What have we done for Christ, in the person of the poor, the afflicted, the orphan, or the widow? God has made us the depositaries of His holy word; what have we done with the light and truth given us to make men wise unto salvation? No value is attached to a mere profession of faith in Christ; only the love which is shown by works is counted genuine. Yet it is love alone which in the sight of Heaven makes any act of value. Whatever is done from love, however small

it may appear in the estimation of men, is accepted and rewarded of God." Great Controversy p. 487

"The hidden selfishness of men stands revealed in the books of heaven. There is the record of unfulfilled duties to their fellow men, of forgetfulness of the Saviour's claims. There they will see how often were given to Satan the time, thought, and strength that belonged to Christ. Sad is the record which angels bear to heaven. Intelligent beings, professed followers of Christ, are absorbed in the acquirement of worldly possessions or the enjoyment of earthly pleasures. Money, time, and strength are sacrificed for display and self-indulgence; but few are the moments devoted to prayer, to the searching of the Scriptures, to humiliation of soul and confession of sin." Great Controversy p.

We cannot allow Satan to distract us away from God's truth. The work of Christ as our High Priest, the sanctuary message and investigative judgment should be deeply studied and understood by the faithful. Daily study, prayer, forsaking sin, and doing the will of God will keep you faithful as you abide in Christ.

We must closely examine ourselves in relation to the Bible and the character of Jesus Christ. This is a serious work of reflection that we all must do individually. Is my life totally hidden in Christ? Have I confessed and forsaken ALL sin and worldliness out of my life? Have I created an atmosphere of truth for me and my family? Have I placed ALL my time, talents, and money in the hands of Jesus? Do my actions reveal that I truly believe that Jesus' coming is extremely soon?

Endure, don't be allured away from the truth. What will you be doing when God pronounces your judgment in the Heavenly court room. This is not the time to be allured and distracted by the entertainment and amusements of this world. We must stay firm on the platform of truth. Remember we are on the battleground, not a playground. We must fight for TRUTH and there will be great resistance, but we must remain faithful. DO NOT look to others as your standard in this fight of faith. Remember, the great number of professed Christians will try to allure you on the "Carnival" cruise ship full of amusements and pleasures that please the flesh. Stay on the battleship of truth. Amen....

We are living at the end of the judgment. Are you ready? Are you ready? You must be ready NOW. You do not know the day in which your name will go before the judgment seat of God, based on the rapid fulfillment of Bible prophecy that day could be any day now.





What is the power of the Bible? 1- Power to Change lives



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



The Bible has proven to be inspired by God time and time again. It never fails. The prophecies that the Bible gave were declared by an Omnipotent and Almighty God (Isaiah 46:9,10).


If we want to know the way, what are we commanded to do?


