Like Birthing Pains

It is interesting that the Bible describes the way crises will occur around the world before the return of Jesus Christ as birthing pains; "For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape." (1 Thessalonians 5:3). To understand this analogy you must understand the phases of when a woman goes into labor. At first, the pain is mild to moderate. The contractions only last a short period of time and are not very close together which is manageable for the mother-to-be. This phase may last for hours. However, as the labor progresses, the contractions get stronger, last longer, and are closer together. At the final phase of birthing pain, the contractions seem to be continuous and are extremely intense. Understanding this process with its phases helps us understand the current events.

Covid-19 with its lockdowns, followed by the mask orders, and vaccine mandates have had an impact on the world. Recently, the order to wear masks was relaxed along with the requirement to show vaccine passports which were required in some states even in America. Many people began to express relief that it seemed like things were going to get back to "normal" during this pause from the various orders. This period of intermission is to be expected as in the birthing process, but when the next crisis occurs it will hit even harder. Even now there are signs that the next wave will be more intense. For example, there is an increase of Covid in China. A major problem in China is their zero tolerance policy. This time 5 major cities were shutdown with 45 million people on lockdown. The problem is that China is the "manufacturer for the world" and what is happening this time is that manufacturing areas are being hit even harder with the lockdowns. In an article entitled "Shenzhen Lockdown Leaves U.S. Ports Bracing for Fallout" by Bloomberg it talked about the effect of the lockdowns in China having a ripple effect in the United States. In comparison of previous lockdowns to this one it stated, "With the current lockdown being more widespread, the effects could be bigger and last longer, he said." That sounds exactly like the process of contractions in birthing pains.

In America, the National Covid-19 Preparedness Plan released in March 2, 2022 the day after the President's State of the Union Address, reveals that with the next variant the government will leverage the existing infrastructure that has already been established which will enable them to enhance and expand their response. Even now as people are relaxed the wastewater surveillance that was mentioned in the plan is detecting the next increase. "A wastewater network that monitors for Covid-19 trends is warning that cases are once again rising in many parts of the U.S.,

according to an analysis of Centers for Disease Control and Prevention data by Bloomberg."1

As you see this next wave occur, recognize that it will be more intense than before and that this is the way the Bible revealed crises in the world would be like.

The Good News is that birthing pains are a sign that the deliverance is about to come. Likewise, when you see the crises increase in intensity remember Jesus Christ is soon to come. "Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy. (21) A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world. (22) And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you." (John 16:20-22).

Throughout the ages God has had a people who where lifted high above the world as lights in the midst of darkness. In the midst of war and trouble they stood high in God's Almighty fortress filled with the peace of Christ. They stood above corruption and demoralization, as "holy" "without rebuke". In medical and educational pursuits they were the most intellectually and scientifically advanced. They stood above the world because they were upon the firm foundation, Jesus Christ.

We as Seventh-day Adventists are called to the highest standards. As God's people, we are called to be the head, not followers of the majority. We are called to reach the highest standards in all that we do. In our characters and influence, our churches, and in all of our institutions.

Where do we find those standards? These standards are found throughout all of the Bible. When we look at the temple and its services that God had given Israel, there was specific order, neatness, thoroughness in all levels of its administration. The God who created and maintains the universe is a God of order.

God has given us the highest standard for us to reach in our medical and educational work. An amazing blueprint has been laid out before us outlining the purpose and foundation of all of our medical and educational institutions.

Now is the time for us to understand the full width, length, depth, and power of our educational blueprint. Our standard of education far exceeds the standards of any secular institution or agency in all disciplines; in science, in medical work, in

While regular liberal arts universities may have larger buildings, government support and money than colleges and universities that follow the blueprint those things do not determine the educational excellence of an institution. Though many of the regular universities claim to have "higher" education, many universities become a place of downfall for many students who become entangled in drugs, alcohol, and fraternities. This shows the low ethics many of these institutions really have.

God's method of education as laid out in the blueprint is the highest education. The Holy Scriptures are its foundation. The principles of highest education practically prepares men and women to be loyal to God and the greatest blessing they can be to humanity. It develops the character the students will bring into every aspect of their work. It implants within the students a desire, as followers of Christ, to uplift humanity physically, mentally, and spiritually. They do the very work Christ did while on earth being "friends of humanity, truth, and holiness". These are the objects and principles that define the highest education.

Because of their wisdom, Nebuchaneszar, king of the most powerful nation on the planet, wanted these men to stand before

him. (Daniel 1:19) This wisdom was not just for Daniel and his three friends, this is God's desire for all.

The highest standard is also held for our medical work. It is to be advanced, scientific, and work according to the laws of the body. It confronts challenges from lifestyle diseases to the most difficult emergencies. Our Chief Physician is Jesus Christ. It is the object of our medical work to point the sick to the Great Physician, Jesus Christ, who can heal them not only physically and mentally, but also spiritually.

The one and only goal of the highest medical work is our one and only desire to serve humanity in the very way Christ did while on earth not for the purpose of gain, but to offer hope to the hopeless, health to the feeble, life to the dying, revealing to the afflicted multitudes the true compassion of Jesus Christ.

When most of our physicians followed the blueprint they indeed were the head. Many were the leading physicians of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. They advocated temperance and abstinence from tobacco in a time when many worldly physicians smoked and prescribed tobacco to their patients.



The talents, however few, are to be put to use. The question that most concerns us is not, How much have I received? but, What am I doing with that which I have? The development of all our powers is the first duty we owe to God and to our fellow men. No one who is not growing daily in capability and usefulness is fulfilling the purpose of life. In making a profession of faith in Christ we pledge ourselves to become all that it is possible for us to be as workers for the Master, and we should cultivate every faculty to the highest degree of perfection, that we may do the greatest amount of good of which we are capable.

The Lord has a great work to be done, and He will bequeath the most in the future life to those who do the most faithful, willing service in the present life. The Lord chooses His own agents, and each day under different circumstances He gives them a trial in His plan of operation. In each true-hearted endeavor to work out His plan, He chooses His agents not because they are perfect but because, through a connection with Him, they may gain perfection.

God will accept only those who are determined to aim high. He places every human agent under obligation to do his best. Moral perfection is required of all. Never should we lower the standard of righteousness in order to accommodate inherited or cultivated tendencies to wrong-doing. We need to understand that imperfection of character is sin. All righteous attributes of character dwell in God as a perfect, harmonious whole, and every one who receives Christ as a personal Saviour is privileged to possess these attributes. And those who would be workers together with God must strive for perfection of every organ of the body and quality of the mind. True education is the preparation of the physical, mental, and moral powers for the performance of every duty; it is the training of body, mind, and soul for divine service. This is the education that will endure unto eternal life. Of every Christian the Lord requires growth in efficiency and capability in every line. Christ

has paid us our wages, even His own blood and suffering, to secure our willing service. He came to our world to give us an example of how we should work, and what spirit we should bring into our labor. He desires us to study how we can best advance His work and glorify His name in the world, crowning with honor, with the greatest love and devotion, the Father who "so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16.

But Christ has given us no assurance that to attain perfection of character is an easy matter. A noble, all-round character is not inherited. It does not come to us by accident. A noble character is earned by individual effort through the merits and grace of Christ. God gives the talents, the powers of the mind; we form the character. It is formed by hard, stern battles with self. Conflict after conflict must be waged against hereditary tendencies. We shall have to criticize ourselves closely, and allow not one unfavorable trait to remain uncorrected.

Let no one say, I cannot remedy my defects of character. If you come to this decision, you will certainly fail of obtaining everlasting life. The impossibility lies in your own will. If you will not, then you can not overcome. The real difficulty arises from the corruption of an unsanctified heart, and an unwillingness to submit to the control of God.

Many whom God has qualified to do excellent work accomplish very little, because they attempt little. Thousands pass through life as if they had no definite object for which to live, no standard to reach. Such will obtain a reward proportionate to their works.

Remember that you will never reach a higher standard than you yourself set. Then set your mark high, and step by step, even though it be by painful effort, by self-denial and sacrifice, ascend the whole length of the ladder of progress. Let nothing hinder you. Fate has not woven its meshes

about any human being so firmly that he need remain helpless and in uncertainty.

Opposing circumstances should create a firm determination to overcome them. The breaking down of one barrier will give greater ability and courage to go forward. Press with determination in the right direction, and circumstances will be your helpers, not your hindrances.

Be ambitious, for the Master's glory, to cultivate every grace of character. In every phase of your character building you are to please God. This you may do; for Enoch pleased Him though living in a degenerate age. And there are Enochs in this our day.

Stand like Daniel, that faithful statesman, a man whom no temptation could corrupt. Do not disappoint Him who so loved you that He gave His own life to cancel your sins. He says, "Without Me ye can do nothing." John 15:5. Remember this. If you have made mistakes, you certainly gain a victory if you see these mistakes and regard them as beacons of warning. Thus you turn defeat into victory, disappointing the enemy and honoring your Redeemer.

A character formed according to the divine likeness is the only treasure that we can take from this world to the next. Those who are under the instruction of Christ in this world will take every divine attainment with them to the heavenly mansions. And in heaven we are continually to improve. How important, then, is the development of character in this life.

The heavenly intelligences will work with the human agent who seeks with determined faith that perfection of character which will reach out to perfection in action. To everyone engaged in this work Christ says, I am at your right hand to help you.

Reform or Revolt

The Bible reveals in Romans 3:23, "For ALL have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." When a person recognizes that they have broken one of God's commandments, they must make a decision if they will reform by making a change to be obedient to all that God commands or to rebel or revolt by continuing to disobey God. According to the dictionary, reform means "to change from worse to better; to amend; to correct; to remove that which is bad or corrupt. to abandon that which is evil". On the other hand, revolt means "to turn, to renounce allegiance and subjection to one's prince or state; to reject the authority of a sovereign, gross departure from duty."

To make a decision to revolt against God is not a small matter, but it is a very serious offense. In Jeremiah 6:28-30 we see its result, "They are all grievous revolters, walking with slanders: they are brass and iron; they are all corrupters. 29 The bellows are burned, the lead is consumed of the fire; the founder melteth in vain: for the wicked are not plucked away. 30 Reprobate silver shall men call them, because the LORD hath rejected them."

Isaiah 1:1-6 gives a visual description to reveal how disgusting a revolt is, "Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward. 5 Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick. and the whole heart faint. 6 From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment." Moreover, Isaiah 59:12,13 says, "For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them; 13 In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revoltH5627, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood." Revolt is apostasy, crime, rebellion. (Strong's Hebrew Dictionary H5627).

Zedekiah revolted against God because he feared the people would mock him. In Jeremiah 38:19-23 the warning was given to him; "And Zedekiah the king said unto Jeremiah, I am afraid of the Jews that are fallen to the Chaldeans, lest they deliver me into their hand, and they mock me. 20 But Jeremiah said, They shall not deliver thee. Obey, I beseech thee, the voice of the LORD, which I speak unto thee: so it shall be well unto thee, and thy soul shall live. 21 But if thou refuse to go forth, this is the word that the LORD hath shewed me: 22 And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house shall be brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those women shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: thy feet are sunk in the mire, and they are turned away back. 23 So they shall bring out all thy wives and thy children to the Chaldeans: and thou shalt not escape out of their hand, but shalt be taken by the hand of the king of Babylon: and thou shalt cause this city to be burned with fire."

Sadly, Zedekiah revolted and it was not well for him. (Read Jeremiah 39:1-8)

When people or nations revolt, God calls for a reformation. During the time of Israel's revolt, Isaiah pleaded with them to reform. "Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; 17 Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. 18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though

your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. 19 If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: 20 But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it." (Isaiah 1:16-20).

Josiah gives an example of a True Reformation. Even though Josiah was the king, he humbled himself and led out in a Great Reformation detailed in 2 Kings 23:2-5,7,10,13,15; "And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant which was found in the house of the LORD. (3) And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant. (4) And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest, and the priests of the second order, and the keepers of the door, to bring forth out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, and for the grove, and for all the host of heaven: and he burned them without Jerusalem in the fields of Kidron, and carried the ashes of them unto Bethel. (5) And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven. Healthy Living Recipes | Pizza

Option #1 Pizza Dough

3 cups wheat flour

1 ¼ cup warm water

1 ½ Tbsp. oil

1 ½ Tbsp. honey

1 tsp. salt

1 ½ tsp. active dry yeast

Place warm water, yeast, and honey in a bowl and let it sit for about 5 minutes. Then mix into the yeast mixture flour, honey, oil, and salt. Kneed it together for about 10 minutes. Then cover with a towel or plastic wrap and let it sit in a warm environment for about 30 minutes. (Note: You can make the dough in a bread machine.)

Option #2 Unleavened Pizza Dough

3 cups whole wheat flour

1 tsp. Sea Salt

3 Tbs. Olive Oil

1 ¼ cup boiling water

Mix flour and salt. Make a well. Pour hot water in the well and then add the oil. Make a dough ball. Knead it until it is a smooth ball that does not stick. Shape in ball. Then roll out flat.



Pizza

"Cheese-like" Sauce

1 cup water (add ¼ cup extra water to make the "cheese-like" sauce easier to drizzle)

1 cup cashews

3 Tbsp. sesame seeds or tahini

1 tsp. salt

2 tsp. garlic powder

2 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice

1 ¼ Tbsp. Paprika (Note: If you want half cheddar "cheese" and half white "cheese" leave out the paprika and pour half of the white cheese in one bowl and then add half of the amount of paprika.)

Blend thoroughly until creamy.

Pizza Sauce

1 (28 oz.) Can Crushed Tomatoes 2 Tbsp. olive oil 1 ½ tsp. salt or to taste ½ tsp. onion powder 1 ½ tsp. garlic powder 1 Tbsp. raw honey ¼ tsp. oregano

Turn skillet on med-high. Pour crushed tomatoes into skillet then add all the remaining seasonings and stir. Cook on low heat about 5 minutes to combine all ingredients.

Assemble Pizza

Put red sauce on the dough. Top with favorite toppings; I like onions, bell peppers, olives, pineapple. Also, add the "cheese" sauce.

Bake the Pizza

Bake in the oven at 350 degree for about 20 minutes.

Is Your Preventive Care Really Causative?

"DESPITE great strides in prevention and treatment, cancer rates remain stubbornly high and may soon surpass heart disease as the leading cause of death in the United States. Increasingly, we and many other experts believe that an important culprit may be our own medical practices: We are silently irradiating ourselves to death."1

There are health conscience people who choose to get a full body CT scan to give themselves peace of mind that there is no disease or discover the disease early. However the FDA has said something which may surprise many about CT scans. The FDA states, "Taking preventive action, finding unsuspected disease, uncovering problems while they are treatable, these all sound great, almost too good to be true! In fact, at this time the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) knows of no scientific evidence demonstrating that whole-body scanning of individuals without symptoms provides more benefit than harm to people being screened." The FDA further states, "Many people don't realize that getting a whole body CT screening exam won't necessarily give them the 'peace of mind' they are hoping for, or the information that would allow them to prevent a health problem. An abnormal finding, for example, may not be a serious one, and a normal finding may be inaccurate. CT scans, like other medical procedures, will miss some conditions, and 'false' leads can prompt further, unnecessary testing."2

Many people get CT scans not knowing that they are actually harming themselves. "The radiation doses of CT scans (a series of X-ray images from multiple angles) are 100 to 1,000 times higher than conventional X-rays."3 That is a lot. CT scans use ionizing gamma radiation which is very damaging to the DNA. These X-rays are like little "grenades" that can cause changes in the DNA leading to cancer. "Ionizing radiation can damage the

genetic material of every internal organ or cell lying within the path of an x-ray beam."4 Radiation also leads to cardiovascular disease by damaging the DNA in your arteries causing the cells lining your arteries to multiply abnormally which effectively decreases vessel elasticity increasing your risk for a heart attack. "In the British study, children exposed to multiple CT scans were found to be three times more likely to develop leukemia and brain cancer. In a 2011 report sponsored by Susan G. Komen, the Institute of Medicine concluded that radiation from medical imaging, and hormone therapy, the use of which has substantially declined in the last decade, were the leading environmental causes of breast cancer, and advised that women reduce their exposure to unnecessary CT scans."5

There is confusion as to the actual amount of radiation given. "The dose at one hospital can be as much as 50 times stronger than at another. A recent study at one New York hospital found that nearly a third of its patients undergoing multiple cardiac imaging tests were getting a cumulative effective dose of more than 100 millisieverts of radiation - equivalent to 5,000 chest X-rays...A 2009 study she [Smith-Bindman, director of UCSF's Radiology Outcomes Research Lab] led found that the actual radiation doses from CT scans varied as much as 13-fold for the same test performed at the same hospital, and these doses were much higher than those required to make a diagnosis...Another said that in her hospital, 'no one cares' about radiation doses."6 "However, according to some estimates, the radiation exposure a patient receives from a full-body CT scan is often 500 times that of a conventional X-ray and about the same as

that received by people living 2.4 kilometres away from the centres of the World War II atomic blasts in Japan."7

Practitioners are not regulated as to their use of CT scans. "The primary U.S. limit for occupational exposure to ionizing radiation is 5,000 mrem (50 mSv)/year. Exposure to minors and to the general public is limited to 100 mrem (1 mSv)/year. Medical exposure levels, however, are based on medical necessity as determined by the physician and patient."8 "The FDA, however, does not regulate practitioners and they may choose to use a device for any use they deem appropriate."9

"CTs, once rare, are now routine. One in 10 Americans undergo a CT scan every year, and many of them get more than one. This growth is a result of multiple factors, including a desire for early diagnoses, higher quality imaging technology, direct-to-consumer advertising and the financial interests of doctors and imaging centers. CT scanners cost millions of dollars; having made that investment, purchasers are strongly incentivized to use them." 10

Urgent Need Of Medical Missionary Institutions

God gives specific instruction to the remnant church on how to establish medical missionary institutions. When people think of the word "institutions" they think of large organizations with large expensive buildings, but an institution is an organization of two or more.

We are instructed to establish many small medical missionary city centers of healing and evangelism in the cities. "We must do more than we have done to reach the people of our cities. We are not to erect large buildings in the cities, but over and over again the light has been given me that we should establish in all our cities small plants which shall be centers of influence." - Counsels On Health p. 481

1) City treatment centers in churches & rented buildings: "In every city where we have a church, there is need of a place where treatment can be given. Among the homes of our church members there are few that afford room and facilities for the proper care of the sick. A place should be provided where treatment may be given for common ailments. The building might be inelegant and even rude, but it should be furnished with facilities for giving simple treatments. These, skillfully employed, would prove a blessing, not only to our own people, but to their neighbors, and might be the

means of calling the attention of many to health principles. - Ibid. p. 468

For example: Hydrotherapy & Natural Therapeutic centers can be established in the city using variety of hydro or water therapies and natural remedy treatments for the sick from various diseases and illnesses.

- 2) Room and places in the city to do health and natural remedy presentations to the community: "Arrangements should be made to hold meetings in connection with our restaurants. Whenever possible, let a room be provided where the patrons can be invited to lectures on the science of health and Christian temperance, where they can receive instruction on the preparation of wholesome food and on other important subjects. In these meetings there should be prayer and singing and talks, not only on health and temperance topics, but also on other appropriate Bible subjects. As the people are taught how to preserve physical health, many opportunities will be found to sow the seeds of the gospel of the kingdom." - Ibid p. 481
- 3) Plant-based & therapeutic restaurants: "I have been instructed that one of the principal reasons why hygienic restaurants and treatment rooms should be established in the centers of large cities is that by this means the attention of leading men will be called to the third angel's message. Noticing that these restaurants are conducted in a way altogether different from the way in which ordinary restaurants are conducted, men of intelligence will then begin to inquire

into the reasons for the difference in business methods, and will investigate the principles that lead us to serve superior food. Thus they will be led to a knowledge of the message for this time."

- Ibid p. 491. These restaurants should have rooms to conduct presentations on health and cooking classes.
- 4) Establish cooking schools in the cities: "In connection with our city missions there should be suitable rooms where those in whom an interest has been awakened can be gathered for instruction . . Cooking schools should be held. The people are to be taught how to prepare wholesome food. They are to be shown the need of discarding unhealthful

foods. But we should never advocate a

starvation diet" - Ibid p. 443

5) Establish Health Food Stores: "Let centers of influence be made in many of the Southern cities by the opening of food stores and vegetarian restaurants. Let there also be facilities for the manufacture of simple, inexpensive health foods up the food work; for, in order to make it a success, the greatest wisdom and economy must be exercised." - Ibid p. 494

All of the institutions can work together in a unified fashion to support and make client referrals for each other. Remember we are all on the same team and are not to compete with each other.

We are instructed to establish medical missionary outposts in the country outside of the cities.

1) Country Sanitariums (Natural

Therapeutic Health Centers) that do not use prescription drugs: "The proclamation of the truth in all parts of the world calls for small sanitariums in many places, not in the heart of cities, but in places where city influences will be as little felt as possible." - Medical Ministry, p. 159

"As to drugs being used in our institutions, it is contrary to the light which the Lord has been pleased to give. The drugging business has done more harm to our world and killed more than it has helped or cured. The light was first given to me why institutions should be established, that is, sanitariums were to reform the medical practice of physicians." - Ibid p. 27

"They (sanitariums) should be situated in the country, in the midst of surroundings as attractive as possible.... The sick should be cared for away from the bustle of the cities." - Counsels On Health, p. 265

Sanitariums should not be too close together: "It is not His plan for an institution to be in too close proximity to another doing the same kind of work." - Medical Ministry, p. 15

2) Medical Missionary training schools in the country should be in connection with the sanitariums: "An educational work should be carried on in connection with all our sanitariums. There is a close relation between the work of our schools and our sanitariums; and, wherever it is practical, there are decided advantages in having a school in close connection with a sanitarium. There would be in such an arrangement decided advantages to both lines of work." - Counsels On Health, p.

Training should not be long years of training. "Some need not spend so long a time in these schools as do others. It is not in harmony with God's purpose that all should plan to spend exactly the same length of time, whether three, four, or five years, in preparation, before beginning to engage in active field work. Some, after studying for a time, can develop more rapidly by working along practical lines in different places, under the supervision

of experienced leaders, than they could by remaining in an institution. As they advance in knowledge and ability, some of these will find it much to their advantage to return to one of our sanitarium training schools for more instruction. Thus they will become efficient medical missionaries, prepared for trying emergencies." - Counsels to Parents, Teachers and Students, p. 469

Also training schools should have a component in which the students learn about farming and help with the needs of the farm onsite.

3) Health food factories should be created in connection with the school and sanitariums: "The health-food business should be established here. It should be one of the industries connected with the school. God has instructed me that parents can find work in this industry and send their children to school. But everything that is done should be done with the greatest simplicity. There is to be no extravagance in anything. Solid work is to be done . . Just as soon as the helpers in this line of work are controlled by the Holy Spirit, the Lord will give them tact and intelligence in the manufacturing of foods, just as He gave the workers on the tabernacle understanding and ability." -Counsels on Health, p. 495

4) Plant-based cooking schools should also be in connection with student training and the sanitarium: "Connected with our sanitariums and schools there should be cooking schools, where instruction is given on the proper preparation of food. In all our schools there should be those who are fitted to educate the students, both men and women, in the art of cooking. Women especially should learn how to cook." - Medical Ministry, p. 270

The Medical Missionary city centers are


to feed the country outpost sanitariums. "I have been given light that in many cities it is advisable for a restaurant to be connected with treatment rooms.. These establishments will serve as feeders to the sanitariums located in the country." - Counsels On Health, p. 488

Industries should be established with school and other medical missionary workers. "Various industries should be carried on in our schools. The industrial instruction given should include the keeping of accounts, carpentry, and all that is comprehended in farming. Preparation should be made for the teaching of blacksmithing, painting, shoemaking, and for cooking, baking, washing, mending, typewriting, and printing. Every power at our command is to be brought into this training work, that students may go forth well equipped for the duties of practical life. Students should be given a practical education in agriculture. This will be of inestimable value to many in their future work. The training to be obtained in felling trees and in tilling the soil, as well as in literary lines, is the education that our youth should seek to obtain. Agriculture will open resources for self-support." - Counsels to Teachers, Parents, and Students p. 310

In conclusion, there is a great and urgent need now for the establishment of the medical missionary institutions. It starts with you. These institution can start small and with only two people. Many people and churches even in the north did not want to go and help them get an education or give them the gospel because of the opposition they would receive from the former masters.

But Ellen White saw the need and called upon the Seventh-day Adventist church to do something. She said, "It is time that every city in the South that can be entered should be worked. The people, both white and black, are to hear the testing message for this time." - A Place Called Oakwood 80.1

She wanted many schools, hospitals, and other industries to be established to help the freed slaves out of their poverty.

Many began to respond to these calls and many missions were set up. Her

son, Edson White had a boat which they called the Morning Star, which traveled down a river to various parts of the south to minister to, and place as a very favorable location for educate the black people. This boat this new school. was a school and also a chapel. It had a publishing press, among many other things.

Edson White co-founded started, a hospital, and a publishing name "Oakwood." house.

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


