Pope Francis goes to Babel (Babylon) to Call for Unity

On March 6, 2021, Pope Francis met with the spiritual leader for Iraq's Shiite Muslims to call for unity. According to an article entitled "*Pope, Ayatollah join in call for peace, unity*" by Democrat-Gazette Staff, this was the first papal visit to Iraq.

Later the same day, the pope met with other religious leaders at "the ancient city of Ur for an interfaith meeting in the traditional birthplace of Abraham, the biblical patriarch revered by Christians, Muslims and Jews."

Interestingly, according to the article the "meeting was held in the shadow of Ur's magnificent ziggurat, the 6,000-year-old archaeological complex near the modern city of Nasiriyah." In other words, the meeting with the religious leaders was held in the same area as the tower of Babel.

Surprisingly, he began his speech by stating, "This blessed place brings us back to our origins," Francis said, "to the sources of God's work, to the birth of our religions. Here, where Abraham our father lived, we seem to have returned home.

The origin of Babel is given in the Bible in Genesis 10:8-10; "And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one [tyrant] in the earth. 9 He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD. 10 And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel...in the land of Shinar." Nimrod was openly defiant to God. Others, who were also in defiance against God, followed Nimrod and began to worship him. Nimrod became known as the sun god and his followers were united together by this sun worship. Babel is the place of origin for the open defiance to the Creator through this false sun worship.

It was at Babel that the whole earth was united as one in rebellion against God by Nimrod. There they began to build the tower of Babel and God was displeased and dispersed them. Genesis 11:9 says, "Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth."

Babel (same as Babylon), means confusion according to Strong's Hebrew Dictionary [H894]. The term Babylon is often used to refer to the confusion that is caused by mixing worldliness and godliness. This Babylonian mixing is often pleasing to people whe want to remain in sin. 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 says, "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? 15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch *Continued on page 8...*

True Unity & The End-time Work

Right before Jesus Christ went to the cross to die for the sins of the world. ratify the everlasting covenant, and make a way of salvation open to all, He prayed for His church. Jesus said, "I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me" referring to his disciples. He knew of the great work which would follow after the day of Pentecost, the opposition they would face and the victory the gospel would attain in countless lives all over the world. But, Jesus knew that this would call for the united work of the apostles, so he prayed, "Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are." (John 17:11)

Jesus also knew that this work could not be done by the 12 apostles alone, but would require the unified efforts of the church as a whole. He said, "Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one....". (John 17:20,21)

That prayer was fulfilled on the day of Pentecost. During this time "...they were all with one accord in one place." (Acts 2:1) While they were gathered together in prayer and humiliation, the Holy Spirit came upon them as "a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting." "They were all filled with the Holy Ghost...." (Acts 2:2.4)

From that time on, the word of God went forth with mighty power. The

Holy Spirit enabled them to speak keep the commandments of God and the truth to the thousands from many different countries in own language. Thousands were baptized and converted to the truth. The work steadily went forward, "and the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul". (Acts 4:32) "...With one mind and one mouth..." they glorified God. (Romans 15:5,6) The truth in Christ was the bond that held them together, and in it they were "...perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." (1 Corinthians 1:10)

By Jesus Christ as our High Priest we receive access to the Father. Through Jesus Christ we receive justification by faith and then can live a life of sanctification which in the end will lead to glorification, eternal redemption, and life at the second coming of Jesus, and the grand consummation of the everlasting covenant, which will be the new heaven and earth.

Though the world says that God's Ten Commandments no longer have to be kept, we affirm that God's law has not been destroyed and we must conform to God's standards through the power of Jesus Christ. The seventh-day sabbath is a testimony "that here is the patients of the saints, here are they that

the faith of Jesus Christ." This is what separates God's true church from the world.

The urgent message we give to the world is contained in the three angels message of Revelation 14 which first calls the people to "fear God and give glory to him, for the hour of his judgment is come" ending with the fourth angels message of Revelation 18 calling the world to "come out of Babylon."

This is the Seventh-day Adventist message! Proclaiming this message to the world is the mission that unites us. The command that Jesus gave to his disciples right before leaving the earth to "go in to all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" is the marching order that God has given his church unto the end of time. Jesus says, "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." Matthew 24:14

This is a large task to accomplish. There are billions of people in the world. There are many difficulties that Satan has tried to erect to stand in the way of God's messengers. The world is engrossed in darkness. How then will the work be done? How will the everlasting gospel in its fullness be preached to every living person on the planet?

In the closing work the spirit of true unity and harmony, as was manifested during the time of the New Testament church, is needed now more than ever before. Only in a spirit of unity and harmony will we press against the darkness of the world and plant valiantly the standard of truth. Only in that spirit will we press against the difficulties Satan has tried to erect in the way of the truth. It is only through that spirit that the everlasting gospel in its fullness will be preached to every living person on the planet. "If Christians were to act in concert, moving forward as one, under the direction of one Power, for the accomplishment of one purpose, they would move the world."—Testimonies for the Church vol. 9 p. 221.

It is like an army. A nation cannot just go out against the enemy one group here, another one there. In order to defeat the enemy they must move forward as one working in harmony. No matter the size of the army, the more united and determined they are, the stronger will be their force. The same is even more required among the soldiers of the cross. The battle that we are involved is a spiritual battle where the eternal destiny of souls for life or death is determined. We "...must have a united, irresistible force; press the battle to the gate, and plant the standard firmly," and every soldier of the cross is to move forward "as if you meant that the truth should triumph." 3MR 13.4

Many have come to think of this unity as just being under one general, formal organization that owns all the churches and institutions, but true unity is much deeper than that. People can be under one formal organization but have very different missions and views which would makes their organization virtually ineffective.

"It is not numerous institutions, large buildings, or great display that God requires, but the harmonious action of a peculiar people, a people chosen by God and precious. Every man is to stand in his lot and place, thinking, speaking, and acting in harmony with the Spirit of God. Then, and not till then, will the work be a complete, symmetrical whole."— Testimonies for the Church 6:293. The fruit of true unity forms a "complete, symmetrical whole"

The truth of God, received into the heart, will do its work of refining, elevating, and sanctifying the life and overcoming the peculiar views and prejudices of each. All should labor to come as near to one another as possible. All who love God and keep His commandments in truth will have influence with unbelievers and will win souls to Christ, to swell the glad songs of triumph and victory before the great white throne. Selfishness will be overcome, and overflowing love for died." 3T p. 435.1

In the human body there are 11 organ You must completely yield your will to God and, through the power of Jesus Christ, work the will of God. When you do this you cannot but have a desire to work for the salvation of souls. As you are working in the will of God, you then will receive the promise of the Holy Spirit. This is what brings about true unity. Teaching Health Principles

Gospel workers should be able also to give instruction in the principles of healthful living. There is sickness everywhere, and most of it might be prevented by attention to the laws of health. The people need to see the bearing of health principles upon their well-being, both for this life and for the life to come. They need to be awakened to their responsibility for the human habitation fitted up by their Creator as His dwelling place, and over which He desires them to be faithful stewards. They need to be impressed with the truth conveyed in the words of Holy Writ:"Ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people." 2 Corinthians 6:16.

Thousands need and would gladly receive instruction concerning the simple methods of treating the sick—methods that are taking the place of the use of poisonous drugs. There is great need of instruction in regard to dietetic reform. Wrong habits of eating and the use of unhealthful food are in no small degree responsible for the intemperance and crime and wretchedness that curse the world.

In teaching health principles, keep before the mind the great object of reform that its purpose is to secure the highest development of body and mind and soul. Show that the laws of nature, being the laws of God, are designed for our good; that obedience to them promotes happiness in this life, and aids in the preparation for the life to come.

Lead the people to study the manifestation of God's love and wisdom in the works of nature. Lead them to study that marvelous organism, the human system, and the laws by which it is governed. Those who perceive the evidences of God's love, who understand something of the wisdom and beneficence of His laws, and the results of obedience, will come to regard their duties and obligations from an altogether different point of view. Instead of looking upon an observance of the laws of health as a matter of sacrifice or self-denial, they will regard it, as it really is, as an inestimable blessing.

Every gospel worker should feel that the giving of instruction in the principles of healthful living is a part of his appointed work. Of this work there is great need, and the world is open for it.

Everywhere there is a tendency to substitute the work of organizations for individual effort. Human wisdom tends to consolidation, to centralization, to the building up of great churches and institutions. Multitudes leave to institutions and organizations the work of benevolence; they excuse themselves from contact with the world, and their hearts grow cold. They become self-absorbed and unimpressible. Love for God and man dies out of the soul.

Christ commits to His followers an individual work—a work that cannot be done by proxy. Ministry to the sick and the poor, the giving of the gospel to the lost, is not to be left to committees or organized charities. Individual responsibility, individual effort, personal sacrifice, is the requirement of the gospel.

"Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in," is Christ's command, "that My house may be filled." He brings men into touch with those whom they seek to benefit. "Bring the poor that are cast out to thy house," He says. "When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him." "They shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." Luke 14:23; Isaiah 58:7; Mark 16:18. Through through direct contact, personal ministry, the blessings of the gospel are to be communicated.

In giving light to His people anciently, God did not work exclusively through any one class. Daniel was a prince of Judah. Isaiah also was of the royal line. David was a shepherd boy, Amos a herdsman, Zechariah a captive from Babylon, Elisha a tiller of the soil. The Lord raised up as His representatives prophets and princes, the noble and the lowly, and taught them the truths to be given to the world.

To everyone who becomes a partaker of His grace the Lord appoints a work for others. Individually we are to stand in our lot and place, saying, "Here am I; send me." Isaiah 6:8. Upon the minister of the word, the missionary nurse, the Christian physician, the individual Christian, whether he be merchant or

farmer, professional man or mechanic—the responsibility rests upon all. It is our work to reveal to men the gospel of their salvation. Every enterprise in which we engage should be a means to this end.

Those who take up their appointed work will not only be a blessing to others, but they will themselves be blessed. The consciousness of duty well done will have a reflex influence upon their own souls. The despondent will forget their despondency, the weak will become strong, the ignorant intelligent, and all will find an unfailing helper in Him who has called them.

The church of Christ is organized for service. Its watchword is ministry. Its members are soldiers, to be trained for conflict under the Captain of their salvation. Christian ministers, physicians, teachers, have a broader work than many have recognized. They are not only to minister to the people, but to teach them to minister. They should not only give instruction in right principles, but educate their hearers to impart these principles. Truth that is not lived, that is not imparted, loses its life-giving power, its healing virtue. Its blessing can be retained only as it is shared.

The monotony of our service for God needs to be broken up. Every church member should be engaged in some line of service for the Master. Some cannot do so much as others, but everyone should do his utmost to roll back the tide of disease and distress that is sweeping over our world. Many would be willing to work if they were taught how to begin. They need to be instructed and encouraged.

Every church should be a training school for Christian workers. Its members should be taught how to give Bible readings, how to conduct and teach Sabbath-school classes, how best to help the poor and to care for the sick, how to work for the unconverted. There should be schools of health, cooking schools, and classes in various lines of Christian help work. There should not only be teaching, but actual work under experienced

instructors. Let the teachers lead the way in working among the people, and others, uniting with them, will learn from their example. One example is worth more than many precepts.

Let all cultivate their physical and mental powers to the utmost of their ability, that they may work for God where His providence shall call them. The same grace that came from Christ to Paul and Apollos, that distinguished them for spiritual excellencies, will today be imparted to devoted Christian missionaries. God desires His children to have intelligence and knowledge, that with unmistakable clearness and power His glory may be revealed in our world.

Educated workers who are consecrated to God can do service in a greater variety of ways and can accomplish more extensive work than can those who are uneducated. Their discipline of mind places them on vantage ground. But those who have neither great talents nor extensive education may minister acceptably to others. God will use men who are willing to be used. It is not the most brilliant or the most talented persons whose work produces the greatest and most lasting results. Men and women are needed who have heard a message from heaven. The most effective workers are those who respond to the invitation, "Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me." Matthew 11:29.

It is heart missionaries that are needed. He whose heart God touches is filled with a great longing for those who have never known His love. Their condition impresses him with a sense of personal woe. Taking his life in his hand, he goes forth, a heaven-sent, heaven-inspired messenger, to do a work in which angels can co-operate.

If those to whom God has entrusted

great talents of intellect put these gifts to a selfish use, they will be left, after a period of trial, to follow their own way. God will take men who do not appear to be so richly endowed, who have not large self-confidence, and He will make the weak strong, because they trust in Him to do for them that which they cannot do for themselves. God will accept the wholehearted service, and will Himself make up the deficiencies.

The Lord has often chosen for His colaborers men who have had opportunity to obtain but a limited school education. These men have applied their powers most diligently, and the Lord has rewarded their fidelity to His work, their industry, their thirst for knowledge. He has witnessed their tears and heard their prayers. As His blessing came to the captives in the courts of Babylon, so does He give wisdom and knowledge to His workers today.

Men deficient in school education, lowly in social position, have, through the grace of Christ, sometimes been wonderfully successful in winning souls for Him. The secret of their success was their confidence in God. They learned daily of Him who is wonderful in counsel and mighty in power.

Such workers are to be encouraged. The Lord brings them into connection with those of more marked ability, to fill up the gaps that others leave. Their quickness to see what is to be done, their readiness to help those in need, their kind words and deeds, open doors of usefulness that otherwise would remain closed. They come close to those in trouble, and the persuasive influence of their words has power to draw many trembling souls to God. Their work shows what thousands of others might do, if they only would. - Ministry of Healing p. 146-151



The god of Ekron (Eradication)

King Ahaziah, Worshiper of Baal

1 Kings 22:51-53 "Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel. 52 And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father [Ahab], and in the way of his mother [Jezebel], and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin: 53 For he served Baal, and worshipped him, and provoked to anger the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done.

2 Kings 1:1,2(first part) "Then Moab rebelled against Israel after the death of Ahab. 2 And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that was in Samaria, and was sick: ..." Interestingly, God gave a warning to prevent this type of accident in Deuteronomy 22:8, "When thou buildest a new house, then thou shalt make a battlement for thy roof, that thou bring not blood upon thine house, if any man fall from thence."

But Ahaziah did not take heed to this warning and he fell from his roof.

The upper chamber was used for many different purposes for family business but sadly as the nation became more defiant against God the rooftop was used as a place to worship their idols as revealed in Jeremiah 19:13, "And the houses of Jerusalem, and the houses of the kings of Judah, shall be defiled as the place of Tophet, because of all the houses upon whose roofs they have burned incense unto all the host of heaven, and have poured out drink offerings unto other gods." example of this, king Ahaz who was a wicked king had altars on top of his upper chamber which were destroyed by king Josiah during their national reformation: 2 Kings 23:12, "And the altars that were on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake them down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron." Likewise, when Ahaziah was on his upper chamber, he was probably worshiping his idols when he fell down through a lattice.

Ahaziah Enquired of Baalzebub, the god of Ekron

2 Kings 1:2(second part)-6 "...and he [Ahaziah] sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease. 3 But the angel of the LORD said to Elijah the Tishbite, Arise, go up to meet the messengers of the king of Samaria, and say unto them. Is it not because there is not a God in Israel, that ye go to enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron? 4 Now therefore thus saith the LORD, Thou shalt not come down from that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die. And Elijah departed. 5 And when the messengers turned back unto him, he said unto them, Why are ye now turned back? 6 And they said unto him, There came a man up to meet us, and said unto us, Go, turn again unto the king that sent you, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Is it not because there is not a God in Israel, that thou sendest to enquire of Baalzebub the god of EkronH6138? therefore thou shalt not come down from that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die.

Ekron means Eradication

According to Strong's Hebrew definition, Ekron means eradication. Furthermore, the word it is from means to exterminate: [Ekron] H6138- "From

H6131; eradication; Ekron, a place in Palestine: - [Ekron]" H6131 - "A primitive root; to pluck up (especially by the roots); specifically to hamstring; figuratively to exterminate: - dig down, hough, pluck up, root up."

Ahaziah was so blind in his rebellion against God that when he was sick he sought after the "go of eradication". It was in the name that Ekron was a destroyer not a healer. This god of destruction, Baalzebub the god of Ekron, is Satan the destroyer. John 10:10 says "The thief [Satan] cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I [Jesus] am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." Satan's goal is to kill and destroy all humanity with the intent of eradication, plucking them up by the roots, like an invasive weed in a garden, so that all are gone forever. On the contrary Jesus' goal is to save life and even moreso to give us everlasting life which is the total opposite of eradication. John 3:16,17 says, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved."

Satan, the god of Ekron, is deceptively working to eradicate humanity. He deceives people into believing that he has some benefit for them. Remember how Satan deceived Eve.(Genesis chapter 3) He promised Eve the benefit of being as the gods in order to get her to disobey God's command. Eve was beguiled because she listened to Satan and believed his lies when Satan was actually orchestrating her destruction. Satan knew that if he could get Eve to sin against God it would lead to pain, misery, and death.

Ahaziah did not get life, but death. 2 Kings 1:16-17 "And he said unto him,

Thus saith the LORD, Forasmuch as thou hast sent messengers to enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron, is it not because there is no God in Israel to enquire of his word? therefore thou shalt not come down off that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die. 17 So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken..."

Why go to the God of Ekron when God Wants to Give Us Life? Why go to a destroyer for healing when God has a plan to boost our immune system and fight against disease? We should trust God because He wants to give life not destroy it. We should follow God's principles to boost our immune system and use His natural remedies that have been proven to be effective for healing.

The Water Cure

Water is God's rich blessing He has provided for us. All the cells in our body need water in order to function properly. The body is made up of around 65% to 70% percent of water and many diseases and pains are the body's "cry" for more water. Our nose, lungs, throat, mouth, and sinuses contain a protective and moisturizing layer called mucus which traps viruses and bacteria to prevent them from spreading in our body. When the body is properly hydrated the mucus is thin and fluid but when the body does not get enough water the mucus is thick and not able to do its job as well which can result in disease. Water increases the body's ability to fight infections and helps flush clean the body of waste. If someone has a fever, the body loses more water which should be compensated by drinking more water to provide relief. Your blood is made up of about 90% water and your blood carries oxygen throughout your body, so lack of water will lead to a lot of problems. Drinking plenty of water helps prevent clogging of blood vessels, treats urinary tract infections, helps treat kidney stones and normalizes your blood pressure.

Drinking a lot of water is very important to keep your body hydrated. Dehydration is bad for those with asthma because a lack of water causes the body's airways to constrict. Dehydration has a negative effect on the brain and many times headaches are caused by a lack of water. Even your joints are lubricated with water, so lack of water leads to joint pain. You may be surprised that many of the

health conditions that people deal with today can be prevented or treated by drinking plenty of water.

Water is even good externally. Hydrotherapy is what you hear in its name hydro - water, therapy - treatment. Even the simple bath is important for health. God taught the children of Israel hygiene. His instructing was, "And if he that hath the issue spit upon him that is clean; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the even." Leviticus 15:8. The effectiveness of hydrotherapy is seen in many cases.

Sister Elizabeth Kenny was a self-trained nurse who successfully used hydrotherapy in treating polio. Sister Kenny would use hot moist cloths on their muscles and would bend and flex their joints as we know as physical therapy. She saw the moist heat relieve their pain. Many disabled polio victims recovered from her treatments and were able to walk. "Kenny wrote that a little girl woke up very much relieved and said, 'Please, I want them rags that well my legs." https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Elizabeth_Kenny#Work.

Diphtheria was a very serious infection that was spreading in which many children died. Two of James and Ellen White's children got infected. Around this time they received an article entitled,

"Diphtheria, Its Causes, Treatment and Cure." by Dr. James C. Jackson. The treatment that Dr. Jackson suggested in his article was simple using only towels, sheets, a washtub and blankets. James and Ellen White immediately the used the remedy for their children and they recovered. "Jackson reported that over a period of years, while employing these means in hundreds of cases involving young and old, not one patient had been lost. The methods he set forth were those that he, a physician with a good understanding of physiology, had reasoned out and put together. He stated: 'Our success has been so great, while as yet our plan of treatment has been so simple..."Ellen G. White Volume 2 The Progressive Years 1862-1876, By Arthur L. White (1986) page 13 paragraph 6

Medical Ministry page 228 paragraph 2 reads, "Experimenting in drugs is a very expensive business. Paralysis of the brain and tongue is often the result, and the victims die an unnatural death, when, if they had been treated perseveringly, with unwearied, unrelaxed diligence with hot and cold water, hot compresses, packs, and dripping sheet, they would be alive today."

How Drugs Work

Would you pour any type of liquid in the gas tank of your car without knowing what it is? Of course not. So why do millions of people swallow or inject prescription drugs without a clue of what is in them! A car is replaceable, a human life is not! Normally when a patient is prescribed drugs they are given the advertised purpose of the drugs. For example, they say blood pressure drugs lower blood pressure, diabetes drugs lowers sugar in the blood, cholesterol drugs lower cholesterol, and pain drugs help with pain. These are all advertised desired outcomes that the pharmaceutical companies sold to the doctors and the doctors passes them on to their patients. The reality is that many of these drugs have poisonous mechanisms of action that manipulate or interfere with normal metabolic biological functions of the body to try to get the "desired" affect that also leaves a trail of "undesired" negative affects.

Let's look at a few examples at the general mechanisms of action of some of the drugs and see how they work.

Hypertension

High blood pressure is known as the "silent killer", also known as hypertension. Hypertension pressure is a warning sign that there are some issues of clogged up blood vessels somewhere in the body. Those with high blood pressure are at risk of a heart attack, stroke, or kidney disease. The following are the

category of drugs that are commonly Diuretics ("water pills"); Beta-blockers; Angiotensin Converting Enzyme Inhibitors (ACE Inhibitors); or Angiotensin Receptor Blockers (ARBs). You have to ask yourself, does any of these drugs get to the root of the problem by unclogging blood vessels? The answer is NO. They are only designed to "play" with the numbers to make it appear that the root of the problem is addressed but in fact it is not. For example, if the blood pressure is as high as 180/90 it is recommended that it is lowered to a "normal" range of 120/80. The patient is prescribed a concoction of high blood pressure pills hoping only to lower the reading of the blood pressure numbers. This gives the patient a false sense of reality because the risk of having a stroke or a heart attack is still the same.

Drugs commonly used - Diuretics ("water pills)

It is theorized that diuretics lower blood pressure mainly by reducing the volume of fluid in the blood vessels. http://heartdisease.about.com/od/ drugsforheartdisease/a/htn_drug.htm . God designed the kidneys as a liquid waste filtering system in which all the blood of the body passes through. The kidneys have a "recycling" reabsorption process to help maintain the VERY delicate chemical balance in the body. The materials that are filtered, and not reabsorbed by the kidneys are excreted as urine waste. The reabsorbing of sodium and water are linked together. The more salt reabsorbed, the more water that is retained in body. How does diuretic drugs interfere with this delicate balance? In general, diuretic drugs act directly on the cells of the kidney that reabsorb sodium. They inhibit the transport proteins that move sodium ions from the filtrate into the cells and then into the blood. In other words, diuretic drugs cancel reabsorption in the kidneys and force sodium and water out!

These are some of the common generic and commercial names of diuretics that are prescribed: Acetazolamide (Diamox); Chlorthalidone (Thalidone), also sold as Tenoretic and Clorpres; and Hydrochlorothiazide (HydroDiuril), also sold as Microzide and Esidri. The following are the "side affects" of these diuretic drugs: Fatigue, muscle cramps, or weakness from low potassium levels, dizziness or lightheadedness, numbness or tingling, heart palpitations, or a "fluttery" heartbeat, gout, depression, irritability, urinary incontinence (not being able to hold your urine); loss of sex drive; menstrual changes, and a deepening voice in women; breast swelling in men or breast tenderness in women; and other allergic reactions. -http://www.nlm.nih.gov/medlineplus/ ency/patientinstructions/000112.htm. Wow! As you can see "water pills" are not as innocent as they sound. They can cause more disease and sickness on top of the high blood pressure.

Beta-blockers:

Beta-blocker drugs artificially slows down your heart rate. It works by blocking the neurotransmitters norepinephrine and epinephrine from binding to receptors. When the neurotransmitters are prevented from binding to the receptors, it in turn causes the functions of epinephrine (adrenaline) to be blocked. This action causes the heart to beat slower thereby reducing the amount of blood that the heart must pump. - http://www.rxlist.com/script/main/art.asp?articlekey=90349. Do you really want to play with your heart chemically by forcing it to slow down? This manipulation of the heart will make the "numbers" come down but the risk is still there! It does nothing for your health.

These are some of the common generic and commercial names of beta-blockers that are prescribed: Acebutolol (Sectral); (Tenormin); Atenolol Betaxolol (Kerlone); Bisoprolol (Zebeta), also sold as Ziac; Carteolol (Cartrol), Carvedilol (Normodyne), (Coreg); Labetalol also sold as Trandate; Metoprolol (Lopressor), also sold as Toprol; and Nadolol (Corgard). http://heartdisease. about.com/od/drugsforheartdisease/a/ htn_drug.htm. How many names were you able to pronounce? The following are the poisonous "side affects" of beta blockers: Diarrhea, stomach cramps, nausea, vomiting, rash, blurred vision, muscle cramps, fatigue, headaches, depression, confusion, dizziness, nightmares, and hallucinations. - http:// www.medicinenet.com/beta_blockers/ article.htm Hallucinations! Is it worth the risk?

ACE Inhibitors:

ACE inhibitors are known as Angiotensin Enzyme Inhibitors. Converting "Inhibitors" in the name should tell you that these drugs inhibit something that is supposed to naturally happen in your body. The blood vessels throughout the body are elastic and made of smooth muscle. They are designed to naturally dilate and contract as the blood moves through the vessels. This dilation and contraction action of the vessel's muscles helps the body to maintain circulation and blood flow. The body naturally produces a hormone called angiotensin that is designed to attach itself to the blood vessel's smooth muscle receptors causing them to contract. After this function is complete the vessel returns to its open dilated position. This process of dilation and contraction of the blood vessels continues as long has your heart beats or unless you take an ACE inhibitor. ACE inhibitor drugs poison and stop the natural production of the hormone angiotensin. This action stops the contradiction of the vessels always keeping them in the dilated state. Again this is playing with the numbers. If the vessel's are forced to stay in a dilated state the blood pressure reading should be lower, but the risk of heart of attack and stroke remain. What do you think will happen to blood flow and circulation? It will slow down and have negative affects the body.

These are some of the common generic and commercial names of ACE inhibitors that are prescribed: Benazepril (Lotensin); Captopril (Capoten); Enalapril (Vasotec), also sold as Vaseretic; Fosinopril (Monopril); Lisinopril (Prinivil), also sold as Zestril; Moexipril (Univasc); and Quinapril (Accupril). - http://www. medicinenet.com/beta_blockers/article. htm. Poisonous "side affects": Cough, elevated blood potassium levels, low blood pressure, dizziness, headache, drowsiness, weakness, abnormal taste (metallic or salty taste), and rash.

ARB's:

ARB's are Angiotensin Receptor Blockers also prescribed for hypertension. They are similar to ACE Inhibitors, but instead of stopping the natural production of angiotensin, ARBs block the binding of angiotensin to muscles receptors on blood vessels. Common generic and commercial names of ARB's:

Candesartan (Atacand); Irbesartan (Avapro); Losartan (Cozaar); Telmisartan (Micardis); and Valsartan (Diovan). - Ibid. ARB's have the same poisonous "side affects" as ACE Inhibitors.

Think about it, does any of these commonly prescribed hypertension drugs do anything to heal the body from hypertension? In addition, according to Dr. Agatha Thrash's book, Emphasis Your Health, A Healthy Journal by Uchee Pines Institute, p.18, she had found several studies that show the negative affects of hypertension drugs. She cites that the most significant study was done by the National Institutes of Health that studied 13,000 men in the United States over a decade. The study found an unexpectedly high death rate in those treated with hypertension drugs. Those prescribed these drugs had a 65 percent higher death rate than those in a control group who were not given the drugs.

Farmacy's Hypertension Healer

The best way to naturally heal hypertension is to eat foods with soluble fiber such as a variety of beans and oatmeal. These foods are known to assist in clearing out clogged vessels! The soluble fiber enters into the blood stream and acts like a natural "Roto Rutter." Studies have also found that four stalks of celery per day for four to six weeks can naturally lower high blood pressure. In addition, those who faithfully follow the entire ANEW STARTT plan will be healed from hypertension!

The Beginnings of Adventist Education

The beginnings of Adventist education started in 1867 when Edson White, who was 18 at the time, looked out of a window and noticed a man working outside splitting wood. Edson decided to go and meet the man. As they talked he found that this was a man who was at the sanitarium to regain his health, named Goodloe Harper Bell.

As they were talking, Bell stated his desire to start a school. Edson asked the man if he could teach him and a few other young men grammar, and that's what he decided to do!

A year later, Bell started a school in Battle Creek, Mi, with Edson and William White (Ellen White's sons) being among the first students. Another notable student was John Harvey Kellogg.

The school was housed in a old rocky building, and in that humble building, he began his school. He was an excellent teacher that was strict, but kind.

In 1872, the school was adopted by the denomination. This was the first Adventist college. The students here where not only to learn book knowledge, but how to work in various skills with their hands. That is what Bell believed, and as long as that system of book knowledge with practical work continued, the school was blessed.

This is one of the main points of the

of blueprint. Students would leave the school prepared for missionary work, and also know how to do some type of trade for their support.

"With a practical training, students will be prepared to fill useful positions in many places." - Counsels to Parents, Teachers, and Students p. 311.3

A Battle at Battle Creek

In 1875 the college at Battle Creek elected a new president named Sidney Brownsburger. Brownsburger graduated from the University of Michigan in 1869. His ideas were not in line, at the time, with the blueprint, and he was not really interested with the vocational teaching that Goodloe Harper Bell had started.

The curriculum he taught was based in the classical education that the worldly universities gave. He claimed that he "knew nothing about operating a program that included industries and farming."— Emmett K. Vande Vere, Adventism in America, Gary Land, ed., p. 70.

Worldly education became the center, and only a few were required to add Bible classes. Thus the school was headed into danger.

In 1881, Brownsburger resigned. The school needed a president but they did not want Goodloe Bell, who was the founder of the school and was still there, to be the president because he lacked a university degree. So they chose a man named Alexander McLearn.

McLearn continued in the same path that Brownsburger has started. He refused to heed the testimonies given him concerning true education. Of the school at that time Ellen White said, "Young men moved upon by the Spirit of God to give themselves to the ministry have come to the college for this purpose and have been disappointed." The school had lost its mission.

A deep controversy erupted between those that liked McLearn's method of education, and those that followed the blueprint which Bell advocated. The controversy became so tense that the school closed down for 1 year.

Bell believed that "The popular method of filling the student's mind with that which is not practical and hurrying him through a certain course, in order that he may obtain a diploma, is not true education. True education begins on the inside, at the core, with that which is practical. It builds up and strengthens a symmetry of character that by and by, in this life, will show itself in some grand, good, and noble work for the world. The school at South Lancaster seeks to attain to this ideal."—G.H. Bell, Review December 26, 1882.

This battle would continue as other Adventist institutions were beginning and deciding on their curriculum.

But the message was given: "Our only safety is to stand as God's peculiar people. We must not yield one inch to the customs and fashions of this degenerate age, but stand in moral independence, making no compromise with its corrupt and idolatrous practices." 5T p. 78.2

He This is the same message for us today.



The Sabbath of the Lord

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The true medical and educational work will be revived. An institution after the order of the blueprint will be established. Reviving the true educational and medical will not be an easy task. Reviving this will take united efforts.






